- Woodland will sequester more than 16,608 tonnes CO₂e over 100 years.
- Project covers 47.68 hectares and was planted in 2018 with mixed native broadleaf.
- An incredibly diverse site in terms of land management and biodiversity.



Project Background

This woodland creation project focuses on biodiversity, ecology, historic restoration and eco-tourism.

Situated in a truly beautiful part of mid-Wales, its adjacency to the local town provides an excellent opportunity for school visits, local engagement and, as mentioned, eco-tourism.

An incredibly diverse site in terms of land management and biodiversity, this native woodland scheme is definitely one to invest in.

The site was planted with mixed native broadleaf in 2018 and is registered as Tilhill Wales Glastir Carbon Group 2019.
