Project Highlights

- Woodland will sequester 2,164 tonnes CO₂e over 35 years.
- Project will create 15 hectares of mixed broadleaved and conifer woodland.
- The woodland will create a valuable shelter from the North Sea winds for birds.
- The project will help to mitigate flooding in the local area.

Project Background

A great opportunity to help develop a 15 hectare mixed broadleaved and conifer woodland creation scheme in a beautiful rural setting, lying close to the North East coast of Scotland in a well frequented tourist area.

The close proximity to Inverness provides a great opportunity to engage with local schools and the local community, whilst also promoting wildlife habitat connectivity and enhancing the already stunning local landscape.

The project is currently in the design phase and it is proposed that planting will start in 2021.

Ecological Features

The project will create a valuable shelter for inland and seabirds from the harsh climate of the North Sea, particularly during the winter months.

It will also help to mitigate flooding in the local area, which is particularly susceptible to flash-flooding.



Location

The land where the project will be created is on a family-run farm, north of Aberdeen.

The new woodland will be very easily accessed, having a good tarred road right up to its edge and only a few miles from major trunk roads.
