### Project Highlights

- Woodland will sequester more than 2,096 tonnes CO<sub>2</sub>e over 100 years.
- Project covers 9.9 hectares and was planted in 2018 with native broadleaf and commercial timber species.
- The area is listed as Open Country and includes a Curlew habitat protection site.



# Project Background

This woodland creation project is a mixture of both native broadleaves and commercial timber species, both of which providing unique benefits to the environment and the local economy.

The woodland enhances the already stunning surrounding landscape, whilst the sympathetic planting scheme enhances the biodiversity of the area, particularly to local bird populations.

The site was planted with native broadleaf and commercial species in 2018 and is registered as Tilhill Wales Glastir Carbon Group 2019.
